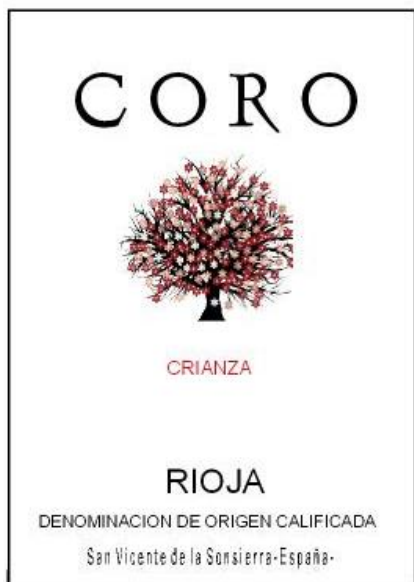

Bodega Antigua Usanza is located in the Rioja Alta sub-zone in the town of San Vicente de la Sonsierra. All Family owned since 1989. They utilize three grapes to produce their red Rioja wines, namely Tempranillo along with Graciano and Garnacha. The name "Coro" is a family name within Antigua Usanza.

Passion and dedication guide Antigua Usanza. They believe that each bottle of wine is unique, an authentic work of art that should be able to satisfy the highest expectations. They adapt to times, new techniques and updating themselves, but without ever losing their essence.

Tasting Notes:

Intense Cherry layers and very aromatic in the nose with Cherry, red berries, toast and depth. Very lively in the palate with balanced red fruit together with hints of cocoa and liquorice. Long sustained finish with weight, complexity and definition
